

## Update – March 2024

### Two-Year Post-Publication Review

In the Chair's IITCSE Report, published on 12 July 2022, it was noted that the Inquiry's Terms of Reference include a two-year post-publication review, designed to assess the extent to which recommendations have been implemented by those organisations responsible.

Work is currently underway in relation to this two-year review. The Chair and the Commissioning Body have already received information in relation to the implementation of recommendations and they are due to return to Telford this month in order to meet with key IITCSE stakeholders. The Chair welcomes contributions from any individual or body which demonstrate the extent to which the recommendations have, or have not, been implemented.

The Chair will detail his findings in a further report, to be published in the coming months.
